Grammatical structure	Pronouns (personal / subject pronouns)
Usage	Use personal / subject pronouns to replace a person, place or thing.
Other examples	My name is Latifah. <u>I</u> like to ride horses. My family likes the beach. <u>We</u> go there when it is hot. I like to go to the café. <u>It</u> is next to the sports shop.



My father's cars are fast.
My hat is in Salma's room.
The Burj Khalifa's windows are made from glass.

Grammatical structure	Nouns (possessive 's')
Usage	Use possessive nouns to show that something belongs to the subject.
Other examples	The <u>dog's</u> bone is in the grass. The <u>student's</u> books are on the desk.



I feel tired.

I play football every day.

I live in a flat.

The pictures are next to the table.

Grammatical structure	Present time (present simple, including the verb 'to be')
Usage	Use the present simple to describe habits and routines and to give facts about things.
Other examples	Alia <u>has</u> two aunts and four cousins. She <u>is</u> not going to school today. I <u>am</u> six years old. I would like <u>to be</u> on your team.
